Article 4-7 of the EVPC Constitution states:

In order to evaluate the requirements laid down in section 4-1, 4-2 and in this article the diplomates are required to send in each 5 years a summary of their professional activities in which evidence of fulfilling these requirements and evidence of continuous education must be included. The format of this summary, which has to be approved of by the European Board of Veterinary Specialisation, will be a credit points system in which the following items can be included:

- publications
- presentations at national congresses or Continuing Education
- presentations at international congresses
- attendance of national or international congresses
- preparing exam questions
- supervision of residents
- membership of Board or College committees

For each item a maximum number of points can be given. A minimum total number of points has to be collected during a five year period. The EBVS recognises only scientific, evidence-based veterinary medicine which complies with animal welfare legislation and, therefore, no credit points can be granted for any activity that does not meet with these criteria.

Individual summary dossiers will be evaluated by the members of the College. An unfavourable evaluation will lead to cessation of registration and Non-practising Diplomate status, unless temporary suspension has been approved by the Board.

Cessation of registration must be approved by the Executive Committee of the College and comes into effect 12 months from the date of notification.
